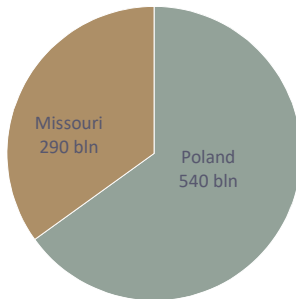

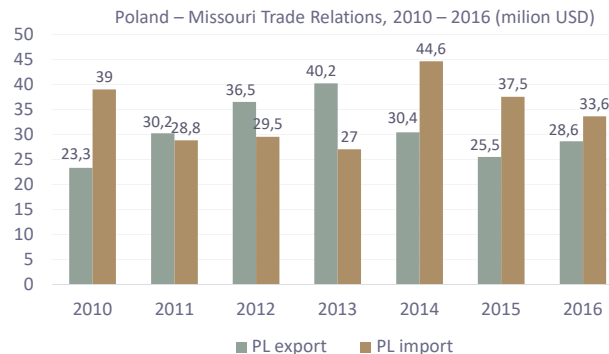
SIZE OF ECONOMIES

TRADE RELATIONS



POLAND

- **6th largest economy** in the EU: 540 bln USD
- GDP per capita: USD 26,403 (PPP, 2015) – IMF
- GDP growth (at market prices) 2008-2015: Poland 40% vs the EU: 12,5%
- **largest EU funds beneficiary**: ~100 bln USD in years 2014-2020
- **low public debt**: 51.0% of the GDP v. the EU average 87.8%
- FDI stock: USD 159 bln as of the end of 2015
- membership: **EU, NATO, OECD, WTO, Schengen Zone, AIIB**
